Parthenium Awareness Week was organized at all campuses of IIPR Kanpur. The details of activities carried out are as follows:

(i) IIPR Kanpur:

ICAR-IIPR, Kanpur, celebrated Parthenium awareness week (16-22 August, 2017) at both campuses of Kanpur. On this occasion Parthenium control programme was organized for whole week under which Parthenium uprooting and application of non-selective herbicide glyphosate was carried out at both campuses. On this occasion an awareness programme was organized on 19th August 2017 in which all staffs of institute assembled at a place. In this programme, Dr. Narendra Kumar, Principal Scientist explained about the Parthenium and its harmful impact on human and animal health. He also added its morphological and reproductive characteristics and highlighted the need of the *Parthenium* eradication and linked it to 'Swatchha Bharat Abhiyan'. He informed that, all campuses are regularly monitoring the *Parthenium* infestation and accordingly taking the control measures. This has resulted in sharp decline in Parthenium population over the years. Dr. Kumar also mentioned about the biological control of *Parthenium* by *Zygogramma bicolorata* (Mexican beetle).

On this occasion, Dr. P.S. Basu, Head (Basic Science Division) appreciated the activities being undertaken at the Institute and efforts is being done towards *Parthenium* conrol along with *Swatchhata Abhiyan*. He also emphasize on health issues from *Parthenium*. After his remarks movement was started to remove Parthenium from main campus. At the end Dr. Rajesh Kumar, Head (Social Sciences Division) shared his experiences and the activities are being carrying out by his division under outreach programme. The programme was organized/coordinated by Dr. Narendra Kumar, Principal Scientist.
